May 10, 2017

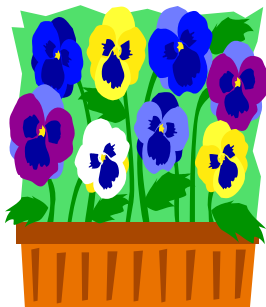

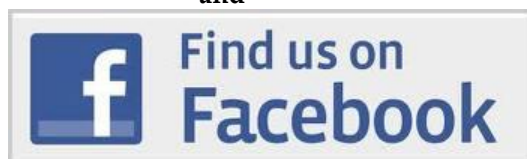
Golf Outing
